Baxter Womack

and His "460 Herd"

Baxter Womack, owner of the Double W Ranch outside of Austin, Texas in Caldwell County is rather an extraordinary cattleman and he owns quite a special Red Brangus cow. Mr. Womack is 86-years young and a retired professor from The University of Texas and a past director for the American Red Brangus Association (ARBA).

Mr. Womack received his beginning in the cattle business when he was a young boy growing up in Charleston, Arkansas. He went to the local bank to get a loan to purchase a Jersey cow. The banker tried to talk him out of getting the loan but Mr. Womack assured him he would make money with the Jersey cow and repay his loan. The banker loaned him the \$75 dollars to purchase the cow that was bred to a Hereford. She produced a good bull calf, that Mr. Womack sold for \$176 dollars to repay his loan and he made a profit to keep going in the cattle business. He paid the loan, as well as the \$2.50 interest on the cow and with the help of his side jobs he was in the cattle business.

Mr. Womack received his first two degrees in Arkansas, and received his PhD from Purdue University in Electro and Computer Engineering, which lead to his 50-year career as a Professor at The University of Texas.

Mr. Womack got interested in the Red Brangus after seeing them on his hunting lease. He would sit and watch them and was amazed at their beauty and adaptability to the terrain they were in. He noticed how they were always in pristine condition and raising outstanding heavy cherry red calves. Because of this he researched them, attended several sales, and decided to purchase Red Brangus.

He purchased his first Red Brangus in 1976 from Mike Levi of Paleface Ranch. There he bought a King Bull and three heifers which was the core of his new Red Brangus herd. Currently Mr.

Womack is the proud owner of a 20-year-old Red Brangus Miss WW 460 cow, whose genetics go back to the initial breeding core he started with the 1976 purchase. The 460 cow has always been very special to Mr. Womack and is the Red Brangus cow that is

known as the '460 Herd'. What makes her so special; she is and has been a powerful producer of consistent top Red Brangus progeny, whether they are bulls or heifers. You ask why he calls it the '460 Herd'. Mr. Womack currently has 20 to 30 daughters and granddaughters of 460 as well as a great granddaughter of 460 which are in his herd. Red Brangus Miss WW 460 cow is 20 years old and has produced 18 calves in her lifetime and she has never missed a single calving season since she was a first calf heifer. The Miss WW 460 cow has been a mainstay at Double W Ranch since the mid-1990s! She is a great milk producer and always weans off a heavy calf that grows very fast and strong and ready to breed at an early age. When her calves are bred, they



don't have any difficulty in calving or producing heavy weaning weight calves. Currently, he is running around 80 head of Red Brangus cows and has them placed in four breeding groups. Over the years, Mr. Womack has kept some of 460's bull calves and used them as breeding bulls. As of this date, all of 460's bull calves

have been kept or sold as herd sires and used at different locations throughout the United States.

Some breeder's line breed to certain bulls, but the breeder that line breeds to a Cow Family will get you plenty of uniformity and consistency of

offspring. 460 is that type of Red Brangus cow and she keeps on producing a line of powerful genetics. She will continue to do that for many years to come, even when she is no longer here. When you pay attention to her pedigree and lineage, you get better cows, plain and simple. 460 has all the traits everyone is looking for in the Red Brangus breed. She consistently passes that on to all her daughters and granddaughters, as well as her sons and grandsons, who all pass that on to all the calves they have produced.

Miss WW 460 is a very feminine, dark-red, moderate-framed lady with an extremely clean underline. She crossed tremendously well with many bulls; her family stands out due to its impressive consistency and uniformity. You know what you're going to get with 460, and you know it's going to be good. She still produces a great calf each year and her calves are constant producers. 460 and Double W Ranch genetics are the type that will help the American Red Brangus breed for years to come The '460 Herd', a cattleman's favorite type of cow.
