I hope this letter finds you healthy amid the pandemic we are all facing.

The AJRBA Show Committee met last night to finalize the plans for our 2020 National Show, and we would like to update you on our decisions.

After long discussions and considerations about putting the health and wellbeing of our juniors and their families at the top of our priority list, we have decided to relocate the show to Wharton, TX. The show will now take place **July 23-25, 2020 at the Wharton County Youth Fairgrounds, 6036 FM 961 Road, Wharton, Texas 77488**. This will allow most families to stay in Texas and avoid the possibility of employers requiring quarantine for employees leaving the state. This facility is also closer for most of our juniors allowing for less travel expenses as well.

We have also modified the schedule to help with the economic hardships that are challenging some of our families. The barn will open on Thursday, July 23, 2020 at noon. The revised schedule can be found on the ARBA website.

The deadline to register for the show has been moved to July 1, 2020.

The WCYF has RV hookups with water and electricity for \$30/day for those that need them. You can contact the WCYF office at 979-677-3350 for reservation information. The Holiday Inn Express & Suites Wharton has given us a block of rooms for \$109.99/night. You can contact the hotel at 979-282-8300 and reference the block number 106205 to get the group rate. The group rate is available until July 8, 2020. We would love to see you in the stands supporting our Juniors.
